A copy of authorize representative papers, power of attorney or guardianship
papers.
Social security card
Driver's license or state ID
Medicare/Health Insurance Cards
Birth Certificate
Health Insurance Premiums/Bills
Naturalization or alien registration forms
Marriage and/or death certificates (for a couple)
Military discharge papers for client and/or spouse
All liquid assets: E.g.: checking/savings accounts (with checkbook register), CD's, stocks, bonds, money market accounts, trusts, annuities owned jointly or individually, bank statements last 5 years.
All life insurance policies. Must verify face and cash values and verified in writing by Insurance Company.
Proof of all income. Must have check stubs for pensions.
Proof if income applied for (VA, SSI, SSD, Annuities)
If you own property, bring deed and property taxes.
If property is listed for sale, bring real estate listing agreement.
If property was sold in last 3 years, bring sales agreement and proof of how the proceeds were spent.
Funeral contract - must be irrevocable for it to be exempt.
Cemetery lot deed
Titles to vehicles
If have secondary or other insurance, must have copy of card and proof of premium and address for claims.
If there is a spouse, must have proof of living expenses that include rent or mortgage, utilities, and homeowners/renter's insurance.
